

SECTION 1: Getting There: Flights, Airlines, Airports, Cruises, & Weather

1. Big Swells Reach SXM from Storms off US Coast

Large swells from big winter storms off the US East Coast were predicted to reach St. Maarten starting on Sunday, January 19, and not ending until Tuesday. According to official predictions, some of the swells could be in excess of 10 feet high.

Such swells were forecast to cause minor coastal flooding in some areas (Maho beach, for example) and they can create dangerous conditions for swimmers. SXM has no lifeguards, so please be sure to swim with others and be very careful in these unusually rough temporary surf conditions.

On Sunday, big waves pushed tons of beach sand onto Beacon Hill Road, for a time shutting down traffic there entirely. For much of the day only one lane was passable. The road, between Maho beach and SXM Airport, is the only way into or out of the populous Beacon Hill residential area. It must be kept clear for emergency access -- a tall order with rough seas pounding the shore.

2. Puerto Rican Quakes: "Naturals" Tsunami Warnings

Local politicians here in SXM are just becoming aware that tsunami warning sirens knocked out by hurricane Irma more than two years ago have not been restored. Hopefully the situation will be resolved quickly so these important warning sirens will be back in operation soon.

In the meantime, be aware that there are certain **natural tsunami warnings** which are nature's way of telling you that a tsunami may be in the offing. Here they are:

<u>"Naturals" tsunami warnings reiterated after Puerto Rico earthquakes</u>. A naturals tsunami warning may be your first best and only warning that a tsunami is on the way. Naturals tsunami warnings include strong earthquakes, a loud roar like a train or an airplane coming from the ocean, and unusual ocean behavior. The ocean could look like a fast rising floater, a wall of water, or it could drain away suddenly showing the ocean floor reefs and fish like a very low tide. If you experience any of these warnings or just one a tsunami could be coming.

3. US Storm Jacob Affects Thousands of Flights

Major US winter storm Jacob started creating all kinds of tumult across much of the United States starting late last week. By early in the weekend, thousands of flights already had been canceled or were expected to be canceled or delayed from the Midwest through the Northeast.

It's peak travel time for flights from the US to SXM for high season vacations and many flights are usually sold out. In our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Group</u> just after midweek last week, we warned passengers leaving this weekend to contact their airlines to see if they could get away early and avoid the need to rebook canceled flights. Many did, especially those who were planning connections from Florida, Atlanta, and elsewhere. Those who are unable to do so, of whom there were many, are now facing the daunting task of trying to recoup what's left of their vacations thanks to this major winter storm, pictures of which have been posted by would-be SXM vacationers in our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Group</u>.

4. Repeat Warning About Airline Schedule Changes

Airlines change their schedules regularly to meet the needs for seasonal travel throughout their route system, for fleet -related reasons, and for competitive reasons. The best airlines try to take care to make sure their schedule changes don't create problems with passenger connections — and some airlines are better at that than others.

Based upon comments from travelers to SXM, it appears that one of the most obnoxious offenders in this area is currently American Airlines, which also continues to make changes as it adjusts to the long-term unavailability of Boeing 737 Max airliners, grounded since March of last year.

Again, we want to remind all our readers who are flying American or any other airline to frequently check to be sure

your flight times are as you expect them to be. Some of the changes American has made can turn single-day trips into multi-day trips requiring a stayover in a connecting city. As well, the airline still has not restored the late-night flight it formerly had from Miami to SXM, which departed early the following morning back to Miami and enabled many single-day connections -- particularly from / to the US West Coast. Hopefully at some point that flight will be restored — it's badly needed.

Although all flights should be checked frequently for schedule changes, April has been a particular bone of contention for our readers; if you have April flights on American, it's important that you check those reservations now and continue to check them periodically.

5. Jet Blue Going Carbon-Neutral on all Domestic Flights

JetBlue Airways has announced that it is going carbon-neutral on all domestic US flights in response to the now well-proven global impacts of climate change. Here is their entire <u>announcement</u>.

Major legacy airlines, and many other large businesses, are expected to follow suit.

6. Delta Being Sued Over Low-Altitude Cal. Fuel Dump

A Delta Airlines flight approaching LAX Airport last week dumped fuel at low altitude over multiple schools where recess was going on, requiring medical treatment for a number of school students. Fuel dumps are normally supposed to be executed at high altitude so the fuel evaporates, or over the ocean. Here, normal procedures were not followed.Here is information about the <u>lawsuit</u>.

7. Royal Caribbean Blames Grandfather for Infant's Death

Royal Caribbean continues to stand its ground, <u>blaming a grandfather</u> for the death of his grandchild who fell out of an open window on a Royal Caribbean cruise last year.

We are neither judge nor jury here, but it seems to us that situations like this could be prevented by safety officials at Royal Caribbean if they made sure accidents like this weren't even possible aboard their ships. It seems to us that instead of wanting to avoid a financial loss and a PR disaster, Royal Caribbean ought to admit that it faces some degree of responsibility here and stop tormenting the family of the infant that died aboard the Royal Caribbean ship.

8. See Current SXM Weather / Tracking Serious Weather

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

1) <u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.

2) Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well. There are now also active weather widgets on the site's home page.

3) Our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Group</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming.

5) For a quick look at weather radar exactly where you are or where you're going, try the My Radar phone app or My Radar for Windows -- excellent programs.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u>.

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

Download your own NHC Hurricane Chart:

Years ago, before we were all saturated with weather information from cable TV to local (redundant and repetitive) news and forecasts plus weather updates and bulletins on our smart phones, gas stations and television stations offered printed hurricane tracking charts so people at home could try to figure out for themselves whether they were about to get slammed by the latest hurricane.

We haven't seen hurricane tracking chart handouts for years, but if you want one they are easy to get.

The exact charts used by the National Hurricane Center (NHC) are available for download from the NHC <u>here</u>. Select "Atlantic" and you're good to go. You can print out the chart and use it repeatedly, or simply print a bunch of them and use one for each storm that may approach an area of interest -- like, SXM. Bear in mind that this hurricane season may well be frontloaded — so you might want to print a few of these now and *not* save doing that for later.

10. About SXM Hotel Development (Four Projects)

For those who haven't been paying attention over the last few months, there are four major hotel construction projects now underway in SXM.

First, very minor final items are rapidly being completed at the recently opened **Adonis Cupecoy hotel** on Rhine Road in Cupecoy beach, the first new hotel in that area in many years. (There is also a new hotel quietly coming along at the Porto Cupecoy condo complex nearby, near the French border.) Adonis Cupecoy is the first of three Adonis properties to be opened in SXM; the same chain has dozens of properties in and around Paris. Their SXM hotel offers immaculate accommodations and exceptionally low high-season pricing. They do not have a pool or restaurants since many restaurants are nearby and both Mullet Bay beach and Cupecoy Beach are within walking distance.

Second, construction at **Planet Hollywood**, the 465-room resort being built at the former location of Sonesta Great Bay, is now underway. The initial activity primarily regards the Royal Islander timeshare section of the resort as well as site preparations for general construction.

Third, the Secrets Resort in Anse Marcel is rapidly approaching its March 1 opening date, recently deferred from February. Secrets is a high-end chain of all-inclusive resorts which, like Planet Hollywood, is expected to attract a younger and more affluent demographic to the island than its current, somewhat older timeshare-centric demographic. (Canadian tour operators have cancelled March tours to Secrets since they don't send tours to just-opened resorts, creating something of a furor among their customers.) The Resort is saying it expects to open as scheduled March 1. (*SXM Weekly News* will tour it in advance and will post news and pictures in our Everything <u>SXM Facebook Group</u> and here in *SXM Weekly News*.)

Fourth, guests at Dawn Beach Club continue to tell *SXM Weekly News* that construction work is already underway at the Westin Dawn Beach Resort and Casino, where some resort restaurants either already have reopened or are expected to do so at any time. Columbia Sussex, the owner of the property, has remained mum about when the Westin will reopen, though Dawn Beach Club guests continue to say it should be late this year.

Columbia Sussex has also been mum on whether any rebranding is expected. The resort is widely expected to be five-star.

15. Be Careful in SXM Waters!

Like most Caribbean islands, SXM does not have lifeguards. Beautiful SXM beaches can have rough surf and rugged currents just offshore and as a result, some may assume that SXM is utopia and not simply paradise.

Use normal precautions in the water that you would use anywhere else: always swim with someone else and don't

take risks. It also may be unwise to drink, then swim.

Be careful out there.

16. D-Boat Tears Loose, Slams Against Rocks in S/Bay

D-boat, a party boat normally moored in either Simpson Bay or Simpson Bay lagoon, between a week ago Sunday night and Monday tore loose from its mooring in Simpson Bay off Simpson Bay beach and drifted to shore against coral cliffs in the Beacon Hill area. It was visible only yards away from the Beacon Hill scenic overlook.

The boat remained in that position into yesterday, when it started to get pummeled by a new round of high surf, the highest in the last two years.

On Saturday we had seen several boat personnel aboard, apparently examining the condition of the boat, which has no engine and no fuel aboard making environmental issues a non-concern. The boat was stuck in place Sunday and apparently secure.

We have asked D-Boat's owners for information on their plan of action and we expect to publish that information once they supply it in our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Group</u>.

17. Stayover Tourists are Back; P-Burg Sighs Relief

As is usually the case in mid-January, stayover tourists have started returning to the island in great numbers and can be expected to be here through the heart of this winter. Although business in Philipsburg is still not back to its pre-Irma levels, it has improved slightly.

As we previously published here, cruise ships visiting SXM late in their itineraries don't bring passengers here with much money left to spend. They fill downtown streets but they don't fill downtown cash registers except for some lunches, beers, and T-shirts. When many ships are in town, stayover tourists — who are the mainstay customers of Front Street jewelers — tend to stay away.

We recently conducted an extensive interview with Mai-Ling Chun, Dutch side head of Tourism, and will be serializing her comments in future issues of *SXM Weekly News*. The wide-ranging interview touched on many topics, one of which was what the future holds for Philipsburg. We think you will find the article interesting.

Philipsburg merchants have been hurting since Irma visited more than two years ago. Their sigh of relief at seeing many more stayover tourists was clear, but still not reassuring since they do seriously need business after two extremely difficult years.

Got Valentine's Day buying in mind? Philipsburg is the place to do it.

19. 2020 St. Maarten Carnival Schedule Released

From March 31 to April 11, several jump ups, pageants, and other events precede the official beginning of the St. Maarten Carnival on April 14. 20. LeGalion Renovations Just Beginning

Almost 2 1/2 years ago, Hurricane Irma pummeled SXM: it was the most powerful tropical cyclone in Atlantic basin history with sustained winds of 185 miles per hour with recorded gusts up to 240 plus numerous tornadoes. Among many other effects, it obliterated everything on Orient beach and also on nearby Le Galion beach, which has been desolate ever since.

Sadly, one of the landmarks long-missed from LeGalion is Tropical Wave, the low-priced seafood restaurant operated by Patrick Turner that will not be returning once redevelopment has been completed.

Even before Irma struck, the Reserve Naturelle which administers both of these beaches was planning to clear LeGalion and return it to him more natural state. It still plans to do that, with walkways, waste receptacles, etc. It is just now saying it's about to start site preparations in the area and clearing away any debris still left from before.

Hopefully, the renewed natural area will be available for public use next season. The French side's record at executing recovery projects is far from enviable, however.

We will continue to report on this project as it hopefully moves forward.

21. St. Maarten General Hospital Const. Begins

Construction of the St. Maarten General Hospital has begun on land adjacent to the current St. Maarten Medical Center near Philipsburg.

Site preparations and reorganizing parking during construction are both priority items, but heavy construction should

be well underway by this summer. We expect to continue to publish pictures of the project as it moves forward in our <u>Everything SXM Facebook Group</u>.

22. Dutch Side Election: Yet Another Coalition Forming

Nine times in the last nine years, the voters of the Dutch side have selected people they like from more than a dozen political parties to lead country St. Maarten.

Nine times in the last nine years, politicians who became part of coalition governments after such elections have switched their alliances not many months after the coalition governments had been formed, essentially rendering the coalitions impotent. As a consequence, Dutch side governments have fallen nine times in the last nine years.

Now, voters on the Dutch side have again elected people from disparate parties who are setting up yet another coalition government. <u>There is sort of a new wrinkle this time, however -- the politicians are saying that this time they will actually stay put and not jump ship from one party to another</u>. Weary voters hoping for a government that actually stays together and gets many important priorities accomplished are welcoming these promises — and of course, hoping they actually happen.

23. Airport Still Waiting for \$\$\$

As we reported several weeks ago, officials from the Dutch side government went to DC to sign the papers enabling the Dutch side airport to receive in excess of \$120 million in financing so it could quickly resume airport reconstruction. Its intent has long been to rebuild SXM Airport better than it was before so it is capable of doing more, better, for the many millions of passengers who will be passing through the facility in the years ahead.

Unfortunately, it isn't that easy.

Contracts have been signed but other ancillary crossing of T's and dotting of I's has not, and the lack of a duly elected government for the last several weeks hasn't helped. Once the new government is in place — which will probably take at least another month — one would hope that all the details involved in reenergizing the airport reconstruction project will get a running start so that everything is finished well before the 2021 or 2022 stated completion date.

24. A Tale of Two Mexican Restaurants...

SXM has two very popular — and very different — Mexican restaurants.

One of them, that has been in business for somewhere around 16 years, is about to go out of business since its lease won't be renewed and its building is about to be demolished. <u>That restaurant is Jimbo's</u>, SXMs most popular TexMex restaurant.

Owned and operated by James Jimbo Morris, whose birthday is coming up on Valentine's Day, Jimbo's is a Simpson Bay landmark that will close with a major party on its last day, March 31, 2020. Jimbo says he is looking for new location somewhere in the same area hopefully and plans to open a new concept — evidently not another TexMex restaurant.

If you have or have not visited Jimbo's, do it before it disappears forever. Our friend Jimbo will be happy to thank you....

The other extremely popular restaurant is an authentic Mexican dining establishment, with a menu extremely similar to upscale restaurants visited today in Mexico. This is authentic Mexican, a very different animal from TexMex. When we recently took people who hate TexMex food with us (kicking and screaming) to <u>La Patrona at Simpson Bay</u> <u>Resort</u> -- they objected until they entered the restaurant and saw its beautiful surroundings... Then patiently waited for the food to arrive. Upon tasting it, they said, "this is like fine dining in Grand Case," -- they were flat-out astonished by how delicious and innovative the dining really was and is. La Patrona has won our <u>Everything SXM Award of Excellence</u> ever since it first opened before Irma struck in 2017; those awards will again be distributed very soon, and you can expect La Patrona to again be a recipient. It is very well worth your visit. Reservations are essential, especially during high season.

25. A Tale of Two Italian Restaurants...

Two of the finest restaurants on SXM are both Italian — and both extraordinary.First we'll look at **Spiga in Grand Case.**

In our view, it's the best restaurant of any kind in Grand Case and one of the top three restaurants on the island. As is the case with the Dutch side Italian restaurant mentioned in the second part of the story, Spiga is not your typical US checkered plastic tablecloth kind of Italian restaurant (though there's nothing wrong with those places). Far from it. It is upscale contemporary Italian dining, with beautiful surroundings, exemplary service, and flat out spectacular dining.

Think of it as a top-notch big-city Fourth of July fireworks display. When you finish one course at Spiga, you may not expect the next course to be equally spectacular — until it happens. There is great creativity here and innovation and the enormous skill set of Chef Ciro Russo and Lara Bergamasco Russo (whose dad years ago owned and operated his namesake Da Livio Restaurant): they know exactly what they are doing.

Whether you crave beef, poultry, fish, or vegetarian entrées, appetizers, and desserts, you'll find it very difficult to locate any better restaurant anywhere. iZi Ristorante Italiano Chef/owner David Foini has been in the restaurant business as long as anyone can remember. He started out as head of culinary aboard one of Royal Caribbean's ships but once he saw SXM, the native Italian knew he wanted to locate here.

His first culinary business venture was La Raviolina in Sandy ground just west of the French side drawbridge, where he manufactured fresh pasta and sold it to restaurants on both sides of the island. His passion as a perfectionist chef and his tireless pursuit of perfection in every aspect of his business shows in the quality of the dining experience at iZi which is why this restaurant is also one of the top three on the island. Every recipe the restaurant uses is a result of thousands of hours of effort at constantly making things better by David himself.
