GETTING HERE:

1. Entry Requirements Update (Important)

With the growing global presence of the omicron variant of Covid 19, nations have been working hard to minimize the impact of this variant on their people and on their healthcare systems. One country doing this is the Dutch side of SXM, home of SXM Airport, where the vast majority of island visitors enter the country.

The Dutch side implemented updated entry Requirements effective January 1, 2022. <u>The most important aspect</u> of the announcement is that people who are fully vaccinated and have received a booster within a specified time period before their flights (9 months) still do not need to be tested prior to visiting SXM. That fact is huge, since in an unscientific survey we took a few weeks ago, it appeared that the vast majority of people visiting the island are fully vaccinated — and by now, likely boosted as well.

Here are two key items of interest. The first is the entire text of the announcement of the new Entry Requirements effective January 1, 2022:

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS SCHEDULED TO CHANGE AS OF JANUARY 1ST 2022; APPLICABLE FOR PERSONS 18 YEARS AND UP

22 December 2021

Minister of Public Health, Social Development and Labor (VSA) Omar Ottley hereby informs the public that, given the rapid worldwide spread of the Omicron variant, Sint Maarten will be implementing various protective measures.

With Omicron fast becoming the dominant variant in numerous countries, the following changes to Sint Maarten's entry protocols will go into effect as from Saturday January 1st 2022 for all incoming travelers to Sint Maarten.

Unvaccinated persons will require a 48 hour PCR test, while persons who received both doses of an approved COVID vaccine will require a 48 hour PCR test or a 24 hour antigen test. **Persons who are 18 years and older and who have taken a booster shot will be able to enter Sint Maarten without a COVID-19 test**.

Persons 17 years and younger who are eligible to take a COVID-19 vaccine can enter without a COVID-19 test once they have taken both doses of an approved COVID vaccine.

<u>SECOND Item of Interest</u>... SXM Weekly News has obtained the information below which was supplied by EHAS to airlines and other affected parties last week. It gives a concise readout of what's happening:

Entry Requirements as of January 1, 2022 As per decision minister VSA

Note: changes will be programmed on December 29 late evening in order to be effective as of January 1. There may be a few arrivals on 30 of 31 which may slip through.

- 1. All countries very high risk until further notice
- 2. Vaccination requirements:
 - a. Non-fully vaccinated five years and older: 48 hour RT PCR test
 - b. Fully vaccinated plus booster shot (not older than nine months): no test
 - c. Fully vaccinated without booster shot 18 years and older: 48 hour RT PCR test or 24 hour antigen test.
 - d. Fully vaccinated without booster shot under 18 years: no test

3. In the EHAS check a field **minor under 18 yes/no** will be added for your convenience, similar to the child under five yes/no.

4. **A mandatory checkbox for booster shot yes/no** will be added next to the one for vaccinated yes/no at the bottom of the EHAS review page so the booster shot will be added or not to the QR code on the preapproval.

2. CDC Has Good News About Delayed Flights to US & Testing Validity

In case your flight to the U.S. is CANCELED OR DELAYED, please note that your negative COVID test result will remain valid as follows: If the first flight in your trip is delayed past the 1-day limit of testing due to a situation outside of your control (e.g., delays because of severe weather or aircraft mechanical problem), and that delay is 24 hours or less past the 1-day limit for testing, you do not need to be retested. If the delay is more than 24 hours past the 1- day limit, then you will need to be retested.

3. CDC Shortens Recommended Quarantine Isolations

In a remarkably controversial move, the US Centers for Disease Control, CDC, has shortened the recommended quarantine time for people who test positive for Covid.

4. Air Caraiibes A330 Jet Bound for Paris Suffers Engine Compressor Stall After Take-Off

A widebody Air Caraiibes Airbus A330 aircraft took off from SXM last week on what passengers expected would be a normal nighttime flight back to Paris. A few seconds after takeoff, however, as the plane was turning southward over Simpson Bay lagoon and Cole Bay, people aboard the aircraft and people on the ground heard two loud bangs, followed by a short burst of what looked like fire from the left engine.

The plane had suffered a compressor stall, something that can happen in jet engines and for which pilots are routinely trained. The flight crew immediately contacted departure control at the airport and a code red emergency was declared immediately so the plane could quickly return to SXM Airport. It landed safely moments later with no injuries.

A top airport official the following day told us that the plane was expected to remain incapacitated at the airport for about a week so that the failed engine could be replaced. On the morning of New Year's Eve, there was a crew surrounding the engine, whose metal coverings were raised for observation much like a car hood is raised to look at the engine.

By later New Year's Eve, the plane remained parked on tarmac adjacent to airport road a few hundred yards east of the terminal building, clearly visible to passersby. An official of another airline told us that technical personnel from Air Caraiibes were stationed in nearby Guadeloupe. Most likely in this case is that a replacement engine will be flown in from Paris or elsewhere in Europe.

We've seen the aircraft both from airport road and from the opposite side of the airport with a strong telephoto lens and from those vantage points to non-technical people, the engine looks normal — though it clearly wasn't.

The Air Caraiibes flight crew and the air traffic control personnel involved in the return of the flight to the airport minutes after this event should be commended for their textbook response which kept everyone safe both in the plane and on the ground.

5. NEWS About the Future of SXM Airport (Short- and Long-Range) Coming Soon

We are currently working on a major story concerning the future of SXM Airport — both short term regarding the restoration efforts currently underway and longer-term, regarding plans to improve the ability of the airport to serve more people throughout the region more quickly.

6. Flight Cancellations Rise As Crews Are Disrupted by Omicron

Omicron and bad weather were both major causes of cancellations of thousands of flights across the US last week. Crew shortages aggravated by omicron are accelerating as winter weather comes into play on cue to add more havoc to airline schedules.

Airlines have apps that enable you to monitor the status of your flights. Given current weather and omicron conditions, it's wise to make full use of those applications.

7. Flight Disruptions Due to Face Masks Are Few & Far Between

Although flight disruptions due to people objecting to wearing facemasks are widely reported in media, the fact is that they are very rare events.

A seasoned pilot for a major airline explains it this way:

If anyone is worried about flying based on media reports of violent and disruptive passengers: Don't think twice about it.

The incidents you see portrayed in the media are the very rare exceptions to airline operations. I was on approximately 200 flights in 2021, and have not seen anything like what you see in the media.

I know of two flights where passengers have been removed this year:

-One I was operating where passengers tried to upgrade themselves to better seats, then proceeded to mouth off to a flight attendant when he told them they could not sit in those seats.

-One operated by a colleague where a passenger used inappropriate racial language directed at another passenger.

Neither of these incidents involved alcohol or mask issues. The passengers on the flight I operated apologized when they were removed and were allowed to travel the next day.

People make mistakes and have bad days, and violence towards others will not be tolerated or accepted. However, what you are seeing in the media is a gross exaggeration, a sensationalistic version, a glorification of the exception of the reality of air travel today. The chance of you encountering this is very remote.

18A. EHAS and Your Insurance Claim

EHAS and your insurance claim

Part of the requirements to come to St. Maarten includes filling out the EHAS form and purchasing the COVID19 insurance. Your insurance is activated the moment that you test positive for COVID19 by any of the government's recognized testing centers on the Dutch side.

We have had some of our members share their concerns about two or more members of their party testing positive for COVID and having to pay extra for their hotel stay. One would think that if everyone pays individually for their insurance, that the insurance claim would cover them individually. What has been happening is that members are being asked to either pay the full amount for their accommodations or pay the difference of the USD\$125.00 per night.

If you are in a group and everyone is staying in the same room, insurance will only cover up to USD\$125.00 for that room no matter how many people with insurance are in that room. In addition to this, meals are not included in the insurance package. Considering the time of the year when prices are normally higher and the type of accommodations you may have selected, you can find yourselves paying extra for quarantining.

It is very important, at this point, to consider if supplementary insurance should be purchased based on the number of people in your party, the duration of your stay on the island, your budget and type of accommodations you'll need. NOTE: Some plans other than the required plan may exclude coverage of pandemics.

Vacationing on the island still continues to be an amazing experience with hundreds of COVID19 compliant places to visit. We've seen many locals with their masks on serving their patrons and many store owners taking the necessary precautions to keep their visitors safe. We would like to encourage everyone to continue to be safe and wear their masks. <u>While you're on vacation, COVID19 is not, and an ounce of prevention is better than the pound you'll have to pay if you have to quarantine...</u>

19. Front Street "Bricks" To be Re-leveled/Fixed Now

As tourists and locals who navigate Front Street know too well, the roughly 15-year-old thoroughfare is in serious need of repair — which is about to happen, officials have announced.

What's about to happen now is a *repair* of Front Street — not a full repaying. Parts of the road have settled over time so some drivers refer to its surface as moguls.

The good news is that the first step in a multiple step process to repair all the moguls is about to begin. The areas that are settled or sunken will be regraded to yield a flat surface throughout the full length of Front Street. The process is not expected to cause any significant disruption.

All will be delighted once Front Street is easier to navigate and more inviting — especially for people in wheelchairs who have had a hard time with the current road surface.

20. TDH Successfully Used Photography to Campaign Against Beach Trash, Cars on Boardwalk Blvd.

The Dutch side of SXM has only one major print newspaper — the *Daily Herald*. They should be lauded for recently running pictures of cars navigating on what has recently been called the Boardwalk Boulevard, which is officially the Great Bay Beach Promenade which was originally designed for use by pedestrians and perhaps occasional bicycles.

The *Herald* ran pictures of vehicles including automobiles, some small trucks, and motorcycles on the boardwalk where they don't belong. Not long after seeing a couple of articles posted by the *Daily Herald*, the Dutch side government announced that it would start enforcing existing laws by removing cars there illegally and levying fines on people driving cars at other vehicles on the "boardwalk." We hope they do this consistently to keep the promenade clear for pedestrians, as intended — and we are sure that the Herald will keep watching as well and keep the public aware of whether the government is keeping its promises.

The *Herald* also reported that trash containers on the beach were overloaded and not emptied until the end of the day. Perhaps some local residents or businesses are putting trash in those containers overloading them - a practice that needs to stop.

It is never a good thing for tourists who come to the boardwalk looking for a highlight of their vacation to encounter small mountains of trash on one of the island's most beautiful beaches. It's not good for the environment, it's not good for tourism, and it's a poor way to welcome visitors.

21. An Incentive to Get Parked Cars off Front Street Permanently...

At one point, a US restaurant chain had signs in some parts of its parking lots reading "cars parked here illegally will be towed, crushed, and melted." Although the signs were humorous, they made the point that car shouldn't park there.

In St. Maarten, many M and P cars, owned by local individuals, are illegally parked in front of businesses on Front Street. At times, police have come by telling them to move but enforcement is not constant and the unsightliness of illegal parking continues.

Perhaps it's time for SXM to post signs similar to those used at the restaurant chain in the US — and perhaps it really could tow such cars and heavily fine their owners to stop this process permanently....

Well-known morning radio personality from Island92 radio in St. Maarten Jeff "Dr. Soc" Sochrin loves dogs and has stepped in many times over the years to promote the adoption of local dogs by tourists. Adoptions are far less expensive than most tourists may think... and the pets are delivered to local airports around the country by willing SXM tourist/passengers flying on major airlines whose only role is to give a little bit of love to the animals during the flight back home.

Recently, Dr. Soc posted about some pets requiring a flight home and thanks to his efforts, volunteers to accompany them were quickly found. The story appeared Saturday morning, New Year's Day, in our **Everything SXM Facebook Group.** In that article, and in many others that have appeared on our site over many months, dozens of volunteers who have accompanied pets back to airports near their future forever homes in the US spoke about how wonderful their experience was bringing a dog home — and many others have commented over time about their dog's behavior after their adoption. It's an obvious show of affection for their new adoptive families.

26. How SXM's Airport Became a "Parking Lot"

It's a parking lot out there! We're not sure quite how they did it, but SXM Airport parked dozens and dozens of private jets at different points on their tarmac over the last couple of weeks as the rich and famous gathered here, flying into the closest jetport near St. Barth, where most of them gather onshore or offshore on their yachts for New Year's Eve festivities including multiple private fireworks displays.

In recent days, we've had several reports of people again seeing mosquito milk in stores and stocking up — so perhaps everything with mosquito milk is cool. It's a great product that we've used for years and we've not seen it available at retail in the US, though it has appeared available online.

Free Parking: The Pondfill: Unmarked spots: As you drive into town, you can pull into a spot, it's usually

unpaved/dirt/rock area.

Marked free parking spots: There are designated free parking lots on the Pondfill. These are usually full by 11am. If you are an early bird great, otherwise you may have to wait 'til a car pulls out.

New Government bldg free lot: Another free lot, but it's a decent walk to front street. Take the turn by the center roundabout and head toward the white/yellow/green(roof) building.

Paid parking: Center of town: The parking lots is literally in the center of town by the WIB Bank/KFC. This fills up very quickly. **The lot reopened on Monday, December 20, 2021.**

Old Library: This is a new area for paid parking. Very convenient. It is \$2.00 an hour. Easy walk to front street.

Bobby's Marina: This is a little farther down Philipsburg, however it is a great place to park. It's near the grocery store Fairway. Once parked, there is a pathway accessible to the boardwalk via Greenhouse restaurant. Takes you straight to front street. It is a nice scenic walk.
